


## MAINTENANCE ClickitUp®

- 1. Release the moving glass on ClickitUp<sup>®</sup> and let it lift by its own power. Do not force it if it does not go all the way up.
- Rinse out the tracks, where the moving glass section glides up and down, on the aluminium profiles using a water hose. (see figure A) Press down the section to the lowered position. Repeat to lift and lower the glass section a few times (at least 2–3 times).
- 3. Let ClickitUp<sup>®</sup> dry before the next step. It is important that all surfaces are dry and clean before using a PTFE based glide spray, which is the next step.
- 4. Spray PTFE in the gaps (See figure B). Wipe off excessive spray with a soft cloth to prevent dirt from fastening.
- 5. Lift and lower the glass sections a few more times.
- 6. If ClickitUp<sup>®</sup> does not work satisfactorily perform Troubleshooting ClickitUp<sup>®</sup>.
